

Product Care Tre Mezzo

Our upholstery stools are for indoor use only. It is important to note that each product has specific and specialised methods of cleaning and care treatment. One method does not apply to all materials, please ensure you read the information carefully for optimum care and longevity of your specific product.

General

To prolong the life of your product check your product regularly for any visible signs of wear and tear, scratches, stains or any other damage, avoid any direct contact with dyes, coloured liquids and sharp or pointed objects as this may damage the surface.

- Always remove stains immediately before they do any permanent damage to the product
- Avoid placing the product in direct sunlight or near a strong heat source
- Avoid direct contact with any sharp or pointed objects as this will damage the surface

Powdercoat Steel Frame

- Remove any dirt immediately using a clean, non-abrasive dry cloth
- Use a soft brush or cloth with a mild neutral detergent solution to remove dust, salt and other deposits
- Rinse off with clean fresh water
- Clean the base and legs using a water and a mild neutral detergent
- Avoid using scouring cream or scouring pads, as they may scratch the surface
- Wipe dry with a clean soft cloth
- Do not cloth and surface dry with a lint-free cloth

Fabric General Care

- Regular cleaning is important to keep the upholstery fabric looking its best and to prolong its life. Dust and dirt wear down the fabric and also reduce its fire-retardant properties.
- Vacuum frequently on medium power ideally every week, using the appropriate attachment to avoid pilling.
- Do not place fabric in direct sunlight.
- Avoid contact of fabric with sharp objects and abradant materials.
- Upholsteries in private households usually need less frequent cleaning. Annual professional furniture cleaning is recommended.
- Refer to fabric manufacturer's detailed Care instructions.

Fabric Stain Treatment

- Treat spills and stains as soon as possible. Any liquids must be soaked up with a lint free cloth or absorbent cloth immediately.
- Remove non-greasy stains by carefully dabbing with a lint free cloth or sponge wrung out in warm water.
- Remove greasy stains by using an appropriate detergent or solvent. Test on hidden area to ensure fabric and colour are not removed.
- Do not rub, scrub or saturate.
- Seek professional cleaning if soiling is still apparent.
- Allow the fabric to dry thoroughly and vacuum before using.
- These are purely suggestions and cannot guarantee complete stain removal. In all cases, we recommend contacting a professional dry cleaner.
- Refer to fabric manufacturer's detailed Care instructions.
